Pursuant to the New York State Election Law, sections 3-212(4), and 15-09 of the Chautauqua County Administrative Code, we submit the Board of Election's Annual report for the calendar year of 1983.

The political year began with Central Voter Registration, (E.L. ss 5-200) for the purposes of the 1983 annual report on Friday, December 3, 1982.

Few people realize that our county is the 18th largest in population of the 57 counties located outside of New York City. Thirty-nine counties are smaller! All election expenses must be paid by the county. The Board of Elections is undoubtedly the largest unit of County government that receives mandates from the Courts, Federal and State governments with Z-E-R-O dollars of support!!!

Concomitant with E.L. ss 5-400, ss 5-406 mandates a Purge List to begin in the second week in December and be completed not later than the third week in the succeeding January. All permanent records and data related to the 76,228 enrolled voters have to be individually examined to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a general, primary, or special election during the past four years. A total of 2,995 were removed on January 15, 1984, leaving 73,233 registrants notified by mail (E.L. ss 5-406).

In January, the newly compiled list of Enrolled Voters is sent to the printer, pursuant of E.L. ss 5-604 in conjunction with the need of E.L. ss 8-100 concerning Primary elections. Such lists must be printed prior to the first day of March in which there is a Spring Primary.

Our efforts to process this data is impeded by E.L. ss 5-302 (4) which states that we cannot open the entire year's enrollment (except Special Enrollment) until the Tuesday following the General Election and the process must be completed not later than the 30th day preceding the last day to publish enrollment lists. Registration records under E.L. ss 5-612 and ss 15-118 are used for Village and School District elections; (see ED.L ss 1906, ss2014, ss2606). Election Law ss 15-118 states if such village does not require Permanent Personal Registration, they (Village Inspectors of Elections) shall adopt or copy such names from the registration lists certified and supplied by the County Board of Elections to the extent applicable. The Inspectors in six villages must be sufficiently knowledgeable where the legal village/town lines are in order to extract the registrants to be placed on the registration rolls for Village Elections.

Due to the 1980 Census and the resulting reapportionment, nine villages now have all of the Elections District wholly within the village. They are; Lakewood, Mayville, Celoron, Falconer, Silver Creek, Forestville, Fredonia, Brocton and Westfield.

Since September 1, 1973, all of the 15 County Village Elections are conducted under Article 15 of the Election Law. The Election Officer is the Village Clerk under ss 15-124 of the Election Law. In addition to supplying voter registration lists, the Board of Elections is involved by publishing Village Election calendars; supplying information of the office and vacancies which are up for general village election per E.L. 4-106, 15-104, and V.L. ss3-302, canvassing voting machines upon candidate request E.L. ss 15-126 (3), and such Election Law and procedures as are germane.

Fourteen villages had Saturday registration on Saturday, March 5th and Fredonia on Friday, March 4th. The village election day was on March 15 with the exception of Fredonia which was Monday, March 14th. Village candidates for office had this schedule.

Furthermore, any qualified village elector may register centrally or by mail until 14 days before (E.L. ss 15-118) an election, i.e., March 1st or Fredonia on February 28th. This office must then forward those village Supplemental Registration Lists to such Clerks immediately for the Tuesday, March 15th election (Fredonia, March 14).

Financial reports are required from the village candidates and/or committee where there is population of 10,000 or more residents in the village, or an expenditure of more than one thousand dollars (E.L. ss 14-124 (6)). Only Fredonia meets this population category. However, unless the aggregate receipts of said candidate and his authorized committees, or the aggregate expenditures made by such candidate and his authorized committees exceed \$1,000 such financial reports must be filed irrespective of population. (Rules & Regulations State Board of Elections ss 6200(1 & 2)).

Board of Elections registrants are automatically qualified to vote in Village elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the non-personal method in the Village and school registration system is NOT automatically qualified to vote in a November General Election. (The only exception is the village of Celoron which has adopted Permanent Personal Registration.) Such persons must personally register again under P.P.R. or use the mail registration forms in order to vote in a November General Election. Thus, many village residents and school voters are confused and disenfranchised by this non-personal registration system when they attempt to vote in a November General Election.

Under E.L. ss15-126 (3) candidates may request a canvass of the Village results by the Board of Elections. No such request or canvass was conducted in 1983.

At least 8 months before the General Election, each County, City, Village, and Town Clerk, pursuant to E.L. ss 4-106, 15-104, and V.L. ss 3-302 shall make and transmit to the Board of Elections a certificate stating each County, City, Village, and Town officer respectively, to be voted on at the General Election. Within 3 days after the occurrence of any vacancy in an office required to be filled at the next General Election, such Clerk shall file with the County Board of Elections, a Certificate indicating the occurrence of the vacancy and the position which is to be filled (E.L. ss 4-106 (4)). A vacancy occurring before September 20th of any year must be on the November ballot (P.O.L.ss 42) that year.

Any proposal, proposition or referendum as provided by law, that is to be submitted to a vote of the people shall be transmitted to the Board of Elections E.L.ss 4-108 (b) at least 29 days prior to the election by the Clerk of a County, City, Town, Village, or special district, at an election conducted by the Board of Elections. Thus absentee and affidavit ballots are printed after this date.

The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning the Election Law, petitions, party caucus, primaries, general elections, A.B.C, local option, referendums, special elections, school board elections, fire district, State, National, and September Judicial Designating Convention.

In the month of May, this office completed its twelfth annual voter registration drive within the high schools of Chautauqua County and other areas. Positive response to this effort is shown in the figures below which give a twelve year total for comparison. Such registrants are informed of enrollment, absentee balloting, impending School Board elections, Primaries, Special Elections, and the November General Election.

High School voter registration and field registrations is conducted by our permanent staff and/or temporary help which we use to train many Election Inspectors. The results were as follows:

The Board of Elections administered the Oath of Office to the election Inspectors of Dunkirk and Jamestown on July 13 and 14 in their respective City Halls between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. In Dunkirk, there are 64 inspectors of Elections not including the Alternates (41 signed). In Jamestown, there are 140 Inspectors not including Alternates (62 signed). A two-city total of 103 Election Inspectors were eligible to take the oath of office.

In preparation for the Primary and General Election, a School of Instruction for Election Inspectors and Alternate Inspectors was held in the Hall Clothier Building Auditorium. A total of six afternoon and evening classes was held with a total of 491 persons attending.

All Election Inspectors and ALternates shall be paid not less than \$5.00 for each training session and mileage not to exceed the rate approved by their respective municipality for attending such school (E.L. ss 3-412, 3-420).

A centralized school of instructions permits the use of office equipment, supplies, and voting machine. Written examinations were administered to all new inspectors which covered the Election Law.

This office conducted the 12th Primary Election that permitted absentee voting since enactment in 1974. All 131 Election Districts were involved in the Republican and Conservative Primary held on Tuesday, September 13, 1983. The hours were from noon until 9:00 P.M.

As a result of a Supreme Court Decision on Monday, August 22 (Judge Ricotta), there was a county wide Conservative Comptroller Primary along with six Conservative Legislative contests. The Republican party county-wide Executive primary was a direct result of petitions being filed in this office.

Due to pending court action, primary ballots could not be printed until after August 22, 1983, This was further complicated by local and Legislative District Primaries that crossed town lines. A total of 16 different ballots were needed for this election. The first primary involving the new 25 single legislative districts.

Voting machine and custodian supplies were delivered on Friday, September 2, 1983.

On September 1st, a total of 77,528 mail check cards were sent (E.L. ss 5-712). The computer cut-off date for this mailing was August 20th. An additional 3,340 were mailed on October 25th. A total of 1,356 registered in consolidated registration places on October 15, 1983.

Each of the mail check card mailings contained this statement. "If you or any

registered member of your family are Physically Disabled OR will not be in Chautauqua County on ELECTION DAY, you may apply and vote by absentee ballot". This timely reminder caused an immediate response for absentee ballot applications. The same statement, with similar results were contained in all legal ads. A 46% reduction in postal costs were achieved by having lighter weight absentee ballots and envelopes weighing less than one ounce.

The last date for requesting regular absentee ballots by mail for the September 13th Primary was September 6th. (in person by September 12th). This office finished canvassing all 131 voting districts by September 15th and certified such results to Albany.

On the 1st of September 77,528 computer pre-sorted mail check cards at 11¢ each (total cost \$8,528.17) were sent to registered voters. This mandate (E.L.ss5-712) notifies the voters of the day(s) and hours of local registration and general election and the fact the registrant must re-register if such person has moved. A total of 3,322 registrations were cancelled.

This year only 47 places of voter registration were open from noon until 9:00 P.M. Such authorized consolidation is a direct saving to the 20 towns and 2 cities. The remaining 7 town consist of a single election district.

* Any double report requirement is waived if any Post-Primary Report which falls within a period of five days of another financial filing date (rule 6200.2c).

In addition to the above filing dates, financial statements shall also be filed on the 15th day of January, and July (6200.2b) of each subsequent year until such time as the candidate or committee terminates activities. The cut-off date for accounting purposes is the 11th day of the appropriate month.

Due to the time schedules mandated by the New York State election Law, unusually heavy demands have been made on the County Printing Department by this office. For example, E.L. ss 5-602 mandates the printing of supplemental voter registration lists for each of the new local 1,356 registered voters of October 15th and the 1,270 mail registrants postmarked by October 11th and received by October 14, 1983, must be finished by Wednesday, November 2nd, six days before the election.

Furthermore, E.L. ss5-200(2) stipulates that a qualified person could move up to and including Friday, October 21st, thus changing his address and possibly the election district. Therefore, accurate supplemental registration lists must be printed quickly in this 7 day work period.

This office is mandated by E.L. ss5-602(1) for the distribution of such lists before the sixth day that the General Election occurs. The date this year was November 2, 1983.

The Gubernatorial Election interest is evident also in these categories for various ballots issued in November for several years:

This is the ninth year all New York state Boards of Election are mandated by law to obtain "unofficial" results the night of Primary and General Elections, (E.L. ss 9-126 (2B)). This required the use of many electric adding machines "borrowed" from various departments within the County Court House. Our staff of twelve was augmented by volunteers (mainly Mayville High School Seniors) using thirty-five telephone to receive the unofficial results.

The day following the General Election this office received the election supplies which were returned from all of the 131 election districts, the bulk of which was received before noon.

Traveling bi-partisan teams consisting of permanent employees began the canvass of the 159 voting machines and verification of the results as recorded by the Election Inspectors. This physical inspection was completed by the following Friday at 5:00 P.M. Certified copies of election results were finished and mailed (E.L. ss 9-214) prior to the 25 day deadline after election. The various offices were to be filed with the State Board of Elections, Attorney General, and Secretary of State.

Some notable items that occurred for 1984 are:

- 1) Village of Lakewood will have 5 year Trustee terms beginning April, 1984
- 2) Absentee Ballots postmarked 1 day prior to and received by the Board of Elections 7 days following the election must be cast and counted.
- 3) Senatorial, Congressional, 150th and 149th Assembly Districts were changed due to the 1980 census.
- 4) The 1983, November Legislative election was the first utilizing 25 single member district.
- 5) Town terms of office extended effective January 1, 1984, and the result of the November, 1983, election are:
