As mandated by New York State Election Law, the Chautauqua County Board of Elections has two Election Commissioners, Terry Niebel (Republican) and Joseph Porpiglia (Democrat). The support staff includes eight members who provide equal representation for each of the two major political parties.

The Board of Elections supervises all elections within the county for federal, state, county, city and town offices. This responsibility entails the certification of names of candidates for various offices; printing the official ballots and voting machine supplies; and tallying the election results. In preparation for each election, the Board processes and maintains voter registration forms, I.D. cards and applications for absentee ballots. A school of instruction provides the election inspectors with an update on the election laws concerning registration and voter qualifications.

In 1987, the Board of Elections was responsible for maintaining permanent records on 77,450 registered voters. These records are individually examined each year to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a General, Primary or Special Election during the past four (4) years. If a voter does not vote at least once during a four (4) year period, his registration is cancelled (purged). Before January 15, 1988, registrants were notified of their cancellation for not meeting this requirement, and advised of their right to register. E.L. ss 5-400(1),ss 5-402(2).

Since September 1, 1983, all of the fifteen (15) Village Elections are conducted under Article 15 of the New York State Election Law. The Election Officer is the Village Clerk. In addition to supplying Voter Registration and Permanently Disabled Voter lists, the Board of Elections is involved in publishing Village Election calendars; supplying information of the offices and vacancies which are up for election. Also, candidates may request the Board of Elections to recanvass Village Election results.

Board of Elections registrants are automatically qualified to vote in Village elections. Conversely, an individual who registers to vote under the non-personal method in the Village and School Registration system is NOT automatically qualified to vote in a November General Election. (The only exception is the Village of Celoron, which has adopted Permanent Personal Registration.) Such persons must personally register under P.P.R., or use the mail registration forms, in order to vote in a November General Election.

Fourteen Villages had Saturday registration on March 7, 1987, and Fredonia on Friday, February 27th. The Village Election Day was March 18th with the exception of Fredonia, which was held on Monday, March 9, 1987.

Village candidates for office had the following schedule:

Any qualified Village Elector may register centrally or by mail until 14 days before a Village Election, March 18th or Fredonia on March 9th.

At least eight (8) months before the General Election, each County, City, Village and Town Clerk, pursuant to E.L. ss 4-106, 15-104, and E.L. ss 3-302, must make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City, Village and Town office respectively, to be voted on at the General Election. Within three (3) days after the occurrence of any vacancy in an office required to be filled at the next General Election, such clerk must file with the County Board of Elections, a certificate indicating the occurrence of the vacancy and the position which is to be filled. E.L. ss 4-106(4) A vacancy occurring before September 20th of any year, must be on the November ballot of that year. The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning the Election Law, petitions, party caucus, primaries, general elections, ABC local option, referendums, special elections, school board elections, fire districts, state, national and September judicial designation convention.

During the months of April and May, this office conducted its sixteenth annual voter registration drive at all the high schools throughout the county. Our staff also provides information and registers voters at the Chautauqua County Fair in the month of July. Such registrants are informed of enrollment, absentee ballot applications, impending school board elections, primary, special elections and the November general election. The figures below illustrate a thirteen year comparison:

Chautauqua County has a total of 132 election districts-- the Board of Elections selects and appoints \*(from a list of recommendations) four (4) Inspectors for each district, equally divided between the two major political parties, on or before the 15th day of July for a term ending on the 14th day of July of the following year. E.L. ss 3-400 & 3-404.

\*Each political party, by the first day of May, files an original list of persons recommended to serve as Election Inspectors.

This year, in preparation for the Primary and General Elections, the school of instruction for Election Inspectors and Alternate Inspectors was held in three locations throughout the county. Afternoon and evening classes were held on August 20th in the City of Dunkirk; August 17th in the City of Jamestown; and on August 24th in Mayville, with over 500 persons attending.

The Election Commissioners conduct this annual training school to inform the Inspectors on procedures for the September Primary, the use of voting machines, taking of registrations on Local Registration Day, and the General Election. An examination was administered to all new Inspectors and Alternates and to those individuals who had not attended this school within the past three years. E.L. ss 3-412.

All Election Inspectors and Alternates are paid not less than \$5.00 per each training session and mileage not exceeding the rate approved by their respective municipality for attending such school. E.L. ss 3-420.

On August 17, 1987, 76,096 computer pre-sorted mail check cards were sent to registered voters (postage costs: \$9,131.52, another group of 3,063 cards were mailed after Local Registration Day (postage costs: \$364.32).

A portion of the mail check card also serves as an I.D. card certifying that the voter is a citizen of the United States, this portion of the card should be detached and saved. Along with the voter's name, address and registration number, the card informs the voter of the time and dates for the Primary Election, Local Registration Day, General Election and the location of his/her polling place. A notice on the reverse of the card states that this communication is a routine check to ascertain whether the voter is still residing at the same address and informs the voter of the availability of Absentee Ballot Applications, if he or any registered member of his family will be out of the county on Election Day.

On June 16th, a Special Election was held for the Member of the 149th Assembly District with 25 polling places open from 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. The 1987 Primary Election was held on Tuesday, September 15th, with 40 polling places open from noon to 9:00 P.M. for the 149th A.D. (Conservatives); Legislative District #19 (Conservatives); Arkwright (Republicans); Dunkirk City (Republicans and Conservatives); Hanover (Republicans); Harmony (Republicans); and Stockton (Republicans).

Absentee applications were processed for the Special, Primary and General Elections with over 1,900 voters eligible to receive absentee ballots.

Local Registration Day was held on Saturday, October 10, 1987, at 44 consolidated registration locations throughout Chautauqua County. A total of 1,178 voters were registered.

As of January 31, 1987, enrollment books, containing 75,291 registrants in 132 Election Districts, were printed from computer lists by our County Print Shop. Following Local Registration, Supplemental Registration lists were printed to include each registrant for Local Registration as well as those who had registered since the January 31st printing of such books. A total whole number of registered voters as of October 17, 1987, was 77,449.

E.L. ss 5-200 stipulates that any qualified person who has moved within the county or city of his residence after the last day for registration, may register and vote at the General Election held at least 10 days after such registration, thus changing his address and possibly his election district. Therefore, accurate supplemental registration lists must be printed quickly within this short work period. This office is mandated by E.L. ss 5-602(1) for the distribution of such lists before the sixth day before the General Election occurs, or October 28, 1987.

E.L. ss 3-214(3) was amended in 1986 requiring our office to remain open on at least two business days until at least 7:00 P.M. and on Saturdays from not later than 9:00 A.M. until at least noon in each of the two calendar weeks before the General Election. Our staff was scheduled to meet this requirement.

General Election Day, November 3, 1987, the Board of Elections' office was open from 5:30 A.M. until after the unofficial telephone results were taken and compiled at approximately 10:30 P.M.

Canvass teams, one staff member of each party, began the canvass of all voting machines used in the General Election. The machine canvass was completed on Friday, November 6th. Absentee and affidavit ballots were canvassed in the Board of Elections office, with official results certified on November 25, 1987.

Pursuant to E.L. ss 9-214, certified copies of the election results were mailed to the State Board of Elections prior to the 25 day deadline following the General Election.

Finally, a complete report of expenditures made by the Board of Elections for the calendar year of 1987, up to and including December 1st, was submitted to the Clerk of the Chautauqua County Legislature. E.L. ss 4-138.
