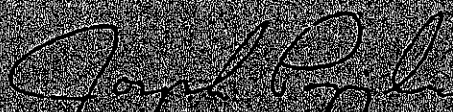

As mandated by New York State Election Law, the Chautauqua County Board of Elections has two Election Commissioners, Terry Niebel (Republican) and Joseph Porgiglia (Democrat). The support staff includes eight members who provide equal representation for each of the two major political parties.

The Board of Elections supervises all elections within the county for federal, state, county, city, town and village of Celoron offices. This responsibility involves the certification of candidates for various offices; printing the official ballots and voting machine supplies; and tallying the election results. In preparation for each election, the Board processes and maintains voter registration forms, I.D. cards and applications for absentee ballots. A school of instruction provides the election inspectors with an update on the election laws concerning registration and voter qualifications.

VOTER RECORDS

In 1991, the Board of Elections was responsible for maintaining permanent records on 71,381 registered voters. These records are individually examined each year to verify if the registrant has voted at least once in a General, Primary or Special Election during the past four (4) years. If a voter does not vote at least once during a four (4) year period, his registration is cancelled (purged). In January 1991, 1,879 registrations were purged.

NOTE: Effective 12/1/91, §5-406 of the NYSEL changed the time and procedure for cancelling (purging) a voter's registration--in part as follows:...The Board of Elections shall, not later than the third week of January of each year following a year in which electors of President and Vice-President of the United States are elected, determine which of the registrants under its jurisdiction had been registered under permanent personal registration throughout the five preceding calendar years and while so registered did not during such five years either vote in at least one General, Special or Primary Election, or Village Election conducted by the Board of Elections. If any such registrant has not, during such five preceding calendar years, voted as aforesaid, the Board shall cancel his/her registration and shall notify him/her of such cancellation.

VILLAGE ELECTIONS

All Village Elections, with the exception of Celoron*(see chapter 359 below), are conducted under Article 15 of the New York State Election Law. The Election Officer is the Village Clerk. In addition to supplying Voter Registration and Permanently Disabled Voter lists, the Board of Elections is involved in publishing Village Election calendars; supplying information of the offices and vacancies which are up for election. Also, candidates may request the Board of Elections to recanvass Village Election results.

*Chapter 359 of the Laws of 1989 was signed into law by the Governor of New York on July 12, 1989, such law took effect on November 15, 1989, permitting a village to have its elections conducted by the County Board of Elections. On March 26, 1990, the Village of Celoron passed a Resolution authorizing and empowering the Chautauqua County Board of Elections to conduct all Village of Celoron elections.

County Board of Elections registrants are automatically qualified to vote in Village Elections. Conversely, individuals who register to vote under the non-personal method in the Village and School Registration systems are NOT automatically qualified to vote in a November General Election. Such persons must register with the County Board of Elections.

Fourteen Villages conducted Saturday Registrations on March 9, 1991. The Village of Fredonia had Registration on Friday, March 1st. The Village Election Day was March 19, 1991 with the exception of Fredonia, which was held on Monday, March 11, 1991.

Any qualified Village Elector may register centrally, or by mail, until 14 days before a Village Election. Exception: Village of Celoron up to 10 days prior to the Village Election.

CERTIFICATION OF PUBLIC OFFICES

At least eight (8) months (exception-Celoron five months) before a General Election, each County, City, Village and Town Clerk, pursuant to (NYSEL §4-106), must make and transmit to the Board of Elections, a certificate stating each County, City, Village and Town office, respectively, to be voted on at a General Election. Within three (3) days after the occurrence of any vacancy in an office required to be filled at the next General Election, such clerk must file with the County Board of Elections, a certificate indicating the occurrence of the vacancy and the position which is to be filled.

The concentration of such information in our office generates many inquiries throughout the year concerning the Election Law, petitions, party caucus, primaries, general elections, ABC local option, referendums, special elections, school board elections, fire districts, state, national and September judicial designation convention.

VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVES

During the months of April and May, this office conducted its twentieth annual voter registration drive at all 21 school districts throughout the county. Our staff also provides information and registers voters at the Chautauqua County Fair in the month of July. The figures below illustrate a ten year comparison:

ELECTION INSPECTORS

Chautauqua County has a total of 132 election districts. On or before the 15th day of July, the county Board of Elections selects and appoints *(from a list of recommendations) four Inspectors for each district, equally divided between the two major political parties. Election Inspectors serve for a one year term beginning on July 15th and ending on the 14th day of July of the following year. (NYSEL § 3-400 & § 3-404)

* Each political party, by the first day of May, files an original list of persons recommended to serve as Election Inspectors.

This year, in preparation for the Primary and General Elections, the school of instruction for Election Inspectors and Alternate Inspectors was held in three locations throughout the county. Afternoon and evening classes were held on August 19th in the City of Jamestown; August 21st in Dunkirk; and on August 26th in Mayville, with a total attendance of 527 persons.

The Election Commissioners conduct this annual training school to inform the Inspectors on procedures for the September Primary, the use of voting machines, taking of registrations on Local Registration Day(s), and the General Election.

All Election Inspectors and Alternates are paid by their respective municipality, not less than \$5.00 per each training session plus mileage, for attending such school. (NYSEL § 3-420)

MAIL CHECK CARDS

Computer pre-sorted mail check cards were sent to registered voters--72,864 in August and 3,067 in October 1991. During 1991, 1,138 registrants were cancelled based on returned mail check cards and additional investigation.

A portion of the mail check card also serves as an I.D. card certifying that the voter is a citizen of the United States, this portion of the card should be detached and saved. Along with the voter's name, address and registration number, the card informs the voter of the time and dates for the Primary Election, Local Registration Day(s), General Election and the location of his/her polling place. A notice on the reverse of the card states that this communication is a routine check to ascertain whether the voter is still residing at the same address and informs the voter of the availability of Absentee Ballot Applications.

FALL PRIMARY

Thursday, September 12, 1991: a total of 5,221 voters turned out for the Primary Election. There were contests in each of the five major parties--requiring Primary Elections in 79 election districts throughout Chautauqua County. In addition to various town offices, there were Primary Elections for five County Legislators and a Democratic Mayoral Primary in the City of Jamestown.

REGISTRATION

Pursuant to NYSEL §5-202, Local Registration was held on Saturday, October 12, 1991 at 36 consolidated registration locations throughout Chautauqua County. A total of 690 voters were registered.

As of January 31, 1991, enrollment books containing names and addresses of 68,521 registrants in 132 election districts, were printed from computer lists by our county print shop. Following Local Registration, supplemental registration lists were printed to include each registrant for Local Registration as well as those who had registered since the January 31st printing of such books. A total whole number of registered voters as of October 31, 1991 was 71,381.

NYSEL § 5-200 stipulates that any qualified person who has moved within the county or city of his residence after the last day for registration, may register and vote at the General Election held at least 10 days after such registration, thus changing his address and possibly his election district. Therefore, accurate supplemental registration lists must be printed quickly within this short work period. This office is mandated by NYSEL § 5-602(1) for the distribution of such lists before the sixth day before the General Election.

GENERAL ELECTION

NYSEL § 3-214(3) was amended in 1986 requiring our office to remain open on at least two business days until at least 7:00 P.M. and on Saturdays from not later than 9:00 A.M. until at least noon in each of the two calendar weeks before the General Election. Our staff was scheduled to meet this requirement.

General Election Day, November 5, 1991, the Board of Election office was open from 5:30 A.M. until after the unofficial telephone results were taken and compiled at approximately 11:00 P.M.

Canvass teams, one staff member of each party, began the canvass of all voting machines used in the General Election. The machine canvass was completed on Friday, November 8th. Absentee and affidavit ballots were canvassed in the Board of Elections office, with official results certified on November 26, 1991.

Pursuant to N.Y.S.E.L. § 9-214, certified copies of the election results were mailed to the State Board of Elections prior to the 25 day deadline following the General Election.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT AND CANVASS OF VOTES
