1993 ANNUAL REPORT



In accordance with New York State Election Law, the Chautauqua County Board of Elections has two Election Commissioners, Republican Terry Niebel and Democrat Joseph Porpiglia. The support staff includes eight members who provide equal representation for each of the two major political parties.

The Chautauqua County Board of Elections conducts all elections within the county for federal, state, county, city, town and Village of Celoron offices. This responsibility includes first and foremost the preservation of one's right to vote. Responsibilities of the Board also include preparing the ballot and canvassing the vote to declare elected officials for all established public and party positions. The profile of government units in addition to federal, state and county at-large obligations include: 31st congressional district (part), 57th state senate district (part), 149th assembly district (part), 150th assembly district, twenty-five county legislative districts, two cities, twenty-seven towns, fifteen villages and one hundred thirty-four election districts.

According to the 1990 census, Chautauqua County has a population of 141,895 of which 105,963 are eighteen years of age or older. In 1993, the Chautauqua County Board of Elections maintained 77,714 voter registration records (73% of those eligible to register).

PRIMARY ELECTION SEPTEMBER 13th

4,955 voters went to the polls on primary day. Enrolled voters of the Democrat, Republican and Conservative parties selected candidates for nineteen various offices to represent their respective party at the general election. Sixty-one election districts were organized to accommodate the fourteen different ballot layouts necessary to record the vote.

GENERAL ELECTION NOVEMBER 2nd

42,793 voters exercised their right to vote on general election day. 210 candidates were chosen for public office to serve at levels that include state, county and town governments. One hundred thirty-four election districts were open to receive voters. Sixty-three ballot setups offered the appropriate candidate selections to the public.

The National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (NVRA) became law in May. This is the single most significant piece of legislation to affect the election system in decades. To meet the required objectives of this act the policies and procedures at County Board of Elections will change dramatically.

A broad outline of the law's intent is to

- ☐ provide increased opportunities for eligible voters to register and remain registered,
- ☐ establish new procedures for maintaining registration lists, and
- ☐ enhance election day procedures to ensure maximum voter participation.

Although much work remains before the specific impact is known, it is important to begin focusing on implementation needs.

The enclosed statistical data for 1993 reflects many of the Board's required responsibilities. However, there are several additional tasks that were undertaken throughout the year that are not recognized by statistics. Whether a project involves an opportunity to address a concern or fulfill a periodic obligation, the goal is to increase the Board's efficiency to public service. A few such undertakings are as follows:

1993 HIGHLIGHTS

REAPPORTIONMENT

Our first project of the year was to implement the County's new reapportionment plan passed by the county legislature in 1992. Twenty-one of the twenty-five county legislative district lines were altered by local law. Thirty-four election district boundaries were changed to accommodate the revisions. Also, two election districts were added.

The Board of Elections also carried out the responsibility of designing a ward system for the Town of Ellicott. The town passed a referendum allowing four single member wards to elect its board members. The uncommon geographical make-up of the town made this task somewhat complex.

The City of Jamestown formed a committee to research the possibility of eliminating a significant number of election districts. Unfortunately, we were not able to accommodate their intent. It became impossible to work within the established county legislator districts and still eliminate election districts.

The domino effect of changing political subdivisions developed into a very time consuming venture. By the time new maps were designed, voter records reassigned (hard copy and electronic), polling place assignments organized and enrollment books printed, it was nearly petition time.

COMPUTER FILE UPDATE

The Board's goal of developing a complete computer access filing system is nearly complete. With the addition of several new terminal stations, each staff member now has the ability to access the Board's main file.

The ongoing effort of enhancing our file layout to include all required data is making steady progress. With the continued support of the county's data processing department, we hope to complete this process during 1994. At the appropriate time, application will be made with the State Board of Elections to eliminate the county's central file (a labor intense, space consuming system).

DIGITIZING

Eleven election districts were chosen to present a pilot program for the 13 September 1993 primary election. This state of the art process of generating facsimile signatures netted positive results. Many compliments were received from election inspectors and voters alike.

The cost saving opportunity of a digitized system is notable. Without the implementation of such a system, the Board of Elections' ability to operate in the traditional manner will be compromised. The additional volume of activity associated with NVRA may be insurmountable.
