# **Glass: Jars & Bottles**

Rinsed and clean clear & colored beverage and food containers only. <u>NO</u> ceramics, light bulbs, ovenware, dishes, drinking glasses or window glass.

# **Plastics**

Rinsed and clean beverage, food, detergent, mouthwash and shampoo containers only. *NO automotive fluid containers, bags of any kind or K-cups.* 

# Metal Containers Aluminum/Tin/Steel

Rinse clean cans, foil, lids, trays, etc. *NO bags or spray cans.* 

### Scrap Metal

Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Steel, Cast Iron, Machinery, Home Appliances, Wire, Pipe, Etc.

# Cardboard

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Paper Bags, Paper Egg Cartons, Cereal Boxes, Toilet Paper & Paper Towel Tubes & Beverage Case Boxes.

NO Waxed, plastic coated, plastic or

foam packaging or food-contaminated materials.

# Paper

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs, Office Papers, Greeting Cards, Books and Notebooks without covers or bindings. <u>NO padded envelopes, pet food bag or bags</u> of shredded paper.

# **Electronics & Small Appliances**

Electronics and small appliances accepted free of charge for recycling.

- Cable or Satellite Receivers
- Electronic or Video Game Consoles
- Printers, printer cartridges, etc.

At home: Print and complete the registration form, listing all materials being dropped-off. Submit the completed form upon entering one of the Household Hazardous Waste Collection sites.
