

Chautauqua County Landfill Commission
Meeting Minutes
August 6, 2025 - Ellery Office

Members Present : Christine, Dan, Aaron, Angie, James, John

Call to order: 6:08 pm

Meeting minutes of the June meeting were not submitted.

Revenue and overall financial posture remains positive thru July 30. Budget performance is similar year over year. Aaron keeps us in the loop regarding new/potential revenue sources. Current mix of waste remains at a 70% to 30% (in county versus out of county). Tentative 2026 budget has been submitted, can discuss further in October meeting as Aaron presents budget to the Public Facilities committee on 10/1.

First semi-annual Storm Water sample was performed and results are satisfactory. Semi-annual Title V air emissions has been sent to DEC, completed in house. Landfill Solid Waste Management Plan is completed, going to public review. Submitted to DEC.

Reviewed the 2026 Capital Projects to include ETS, new equipment requests, gas well maintenance, new south leachate basin liner, and Ellery shop upgrades. Continue to work with B&L on ETS retaining wall.

Phase IV work continues. Radiation detection equipment is installed per the new waste permit requirements. DEC is onboard.

Recycling markets remain flat, but profitable. Waste flow is averaging 823 tons/day. Credit/debit card implementation is moving slow, should be implemented by year end. Of the members present, it was collectively agreed Solar developments are not a direction worth heading now from a commission point of view.

Overall transfer station operations are at status quo with ongoing improvements taking place at NCTS, WCTS. Residential volumes trending up at SCTS.

Continue to discuss leachate treatment concerns (PHAS) and BPU line agreement. Discussed changing from ductile iron to single wall HDPE going forward should a replacement project be identified.
