## Post #2 – Congenital Syphilis

Protect Your Baby from Syphilis

Syphilis is a serious sexually transmitted infection (STI) that can harm you — and during pregnancy, it can seriously harm your baby.

The good news? You can protect yourself and your baby by getting tested during pregnancy.

What is syphilis?

It's an STI caused by bacteria and spreads through skin-to-skin contact with a syphilis sore — usually during sex. A pregnant person can pass it to their baby during pregnancy or childbirth.
