The meeting was called to order at 10:01 am by Bob Franzen at the CC Airport conference room. The minutes for the February 26 meeting were reviewed. Bob motioned to accept as written, Twan seconded and it carried.

Jamie presented the operations report: Parks remain closed; Arkwright update on Open Spaces Grant application, after discussion and consideration has been pulled. CC has received TRP's for Panama lean-to and bridges at Harris Hill: legislation for land in Ellery and Ripley driveway will go to legislature in April: discussion was held on new Bill in assembly and a letter of non-support will be sent by the Commission to Government officials; Mt Pleasant beaver permit is renewed for 1 year; property in Cherry Creek near potential re-route is on sale listing; Ball Rd waterfall area on Canadaway Creek will be looked into. Discussion was held on DEC forest management. Discussion on the lean-tos and new proposed by-laws was postponed until the April CCPC meeting.

The CC properties at North Hill and Ripley were discussed and Jamie will schedule a trip for CCPC members to look at the areas.

Jacob spoke about new NYS forest chainsaw regulations. Greenway summit in April requires pre-registration.

Discussion was held on donations.

Blowdowns continue to be a problem throughout the county. Eggleston Horse trail has been closed due to blockages.
