The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Bob Franzen at the CC Airport conference room. The minutes for the March 26 meeting were reviewed. Bob motioned to accept as written, Bob D seconded and it carried.

Ehren Reynolds spoke regarding WNY MeshCore with a proposal to potentially install a solar powered repeater at Luensman Park for their network of off grid communications network as a backup during emergencies and power outages. He presented the history and operations of the business. Discussion was held and decision tabled until the May meeting.

Jamie presented the Operations report: Erlandson opens May 2 with the Workers Memorial; Luensman opens approximately May 13; Legislature passed the Home Rule Legislation and it will be sent to Assembly and Senate; The Parks crew has been busy clearing downfalls on the trails.
