Instructions

Proposition 1

Shall the following proposition be adopted, to wit:

Resolved, that the budget for the Sherman Central School District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted in the amount of **\$13,933,695** and the required funds therefore are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law.

Proposition 2

Shall the following proposition be adopted, to wit:

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Sherman Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake the acquisition of the following fleet vehicles: one (1) 64-passenger school bus, at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$194,677, one (1) 64-passenger school bus at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$176,420, and one (1) Suburban-type vehicle at an estimated maximum cost of \$73,903, less trade-in value, if any, and that such costs, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$445,000 shall be issued, or the School District may enter into an installment purchase contract if the Board of Education determines that it is in the best interest of the School District to finance the purchase in that method
