Proposition #1
Basic Budget

RESOLVED, that the basic budget for the Silver Creek Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District"), for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted in the amount of \$33,421,717, and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law.

Proposition #2
Vehicle Purchase

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Silver Creek Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District") be, and it hereby is, authorized to purchase, for use in the transportation program of the District, two (2) 66 passenger diesel buses and one (1) 33 passenger diesel bus at an amount of \$505,000, by utilizing that amount of funds currently on hand in the District's voter-approved 2022 Capital Reserve for Vehicles, thereby avoiding the need for the District to borrow; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authorization for the use of reserve fund monies that are already on hand shall have no effect on the tax rate for the 2026-2027 school year.
