Initial Funding of Repair Reserve

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Westfield Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District") is hereby authorized to transfer \$100,000 (during the 2025-2026 fiscal year of the District) from the District's unallocated fund balance of the District to the District's newly-established Repair Reserve Fund which is operated pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 6-d for purposes of paying for the cost of non-recurring repairs to District capital improvements and equipment.
